

Fowey Primary School Uniform Policy

At Fowey Primary School we take pride in everything we do, including how we present ourselves. Our expectations of the pupil's appearance remains high at all times so that they take pride in their appearance too. All pupils are expected to wear the full school uniform.

Jumper/Cardigan	Blue jumper or cardigan with school logo. (compulsory with logo)
Polo Shirt	Smart plain white polo shirt
Trousers/skirt/pinafore	Black trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafores. Skirts must be knee length or longer.
	Summer dresses are allowed – blue and white checked only.
Socks/Tights	Plain black socks or tights.
36	Plain white socks with summer dresses.
Coats	A suitable water-resistant coat with a hood
	for outdoor play and learning must be brought to school every day.

Black shoes





School shoes must be smart, waterproof, plain black sturdy leather or synthetic leather shoes only (not trainers)
Please note: trainers, including all black ones, are not permitted for school uniform. Boots of any kind, sandals, shoes with heels are not permitted.

School bags



Year R, 1 and 2 – Fowey School book bag with school logo

Year 3 and above can use either the book bag or a bag/rucksack of any colour large enough to hold an A4 book.

PE topIn house colours

PE t-shirt with school logo in house colours (compulsory)

PE bottoms

Plain blue sports shorts and or plain blue jogging bottoms



Children should have plain blue shorts and/or plain blue jogging bottoms.

Your child will take part in outdoor PE across the year including winter.

Safe sports trainers



Sturdy safe trainers of any colour can be worn for PE. Black Velcro plimsolls are especially recommended for our younger children.

Hair styles

- Long hair must be tied up (shoulder length and longer)
- Shaved lines/patterns in haircuts are not permitted at school
- Any hair accessories must be understated and either black, white or royal blue
- Hair should be of natural appearance in colour, with no tramlines, extreme hairstyles, patterned or brightly coloured hair.

Jewellery

- For safety reasons, jewellery is not permitted
- A watch may be worn if pupils can tell the time
- One pair of studs are allowed in the earlobe.
- Only simple small metal stud earing can be worn, and they must be removed by the child (or adult at home) for PE days.

All clothing and footwear must be clearly named with a permanent pen or label

Pupils who are not adhering to the uniform policy will be requested to borrow items for 1 day from the school office, in the case of clothing. If incorrect footwear is worn the pupil will be requested to return home to change into footwear that conforms with the Fowey uniform policy.

If pupils attend school with hairstyles outside of the Uniform Policy they will receive a consequence in line with the behaviour policy.

This uniform policy will be in force from September 2022.
