We are all very enthusiastic about our current topic. We have been autumn spotting, collecting leaves, twigs, pine cones and acorns. In English we have been looking at the story 'On Sudden Hill'. We have been very creative making lots of wonderful things with cardboard boxes and have loved the imaginary play it has created. In maths the children have continued working with objects upto 5. We have worked with equal and unequal groups of objects and developed their mathematical vocabulary.











We love reading in Year 1! We used books about the continents to help us plan and write our special story The Plane Ride! In Science, we have had fun making a rain cloud in a jar. We have been learning about what weather we may experience each season.

This week in Gribben, we've had a scrap metal experience.... generating lots of fantastic vocabulary linked to our writing text: The Iron Man . We also had great fun considering different sketching techniques such as hatching, stippling and shading and used charcoal to develop our own predator based drawings

In Science, we loved investigating the effect bone sizes have on our range of movement.





In Coombe class this week, we have enjoyed practicing and perfecting our yoga poses. We have also come to the end of our writing unit on the whale and have started some fantastic pieces of independent writing! In RE have started learning all about Buddhism and the Eightfold Path, which has been very interesting.













We have worked hard in Science this week investigating materials.

We looked at a range of weird and wonderful materials and developed our own hardness scale and scratch test. We learnt about Mohs scale for hardness of materials. The children worked brilliantly in groups to make their scientific discoveries!
