Science: Materials
Intent: To investigate properties of
materials and describe their uses.

#### Sequence of lessons:

- Do you think plastic is useful? Investigate uses of different types of plastic.
- 2. Making plastic from milk! Investigation
- Properties of word: Making Catapults
- 4. Floating and sinking
- 5. Boat designs
- STEM Challenge on properties of materials.

Key Vocabulary: materials, properties, describe, float, sink, density, buoyancy, mass, weight, submerged.

## Geography: What is it like here?

Intent: To recognize physical and human features in their local area

#### Sequence of lessons:

- To locate the school on an aerial photograph
- 2. To create a map of the classroom
- 3. To locate key features of the playground
- 4. To draw a simple map
- 5. To investigate how we feel about our playground
- 6. To create a design to improve our playground.

Key Vocabulary: aerial photograph, locate, map, explore, improve, sea, town, country, symbol, globe, direction, city

## RE: Why does Christmas matter to Christians?

Intent: To understand the importance of Christmas to Christians.

#### Sequence of lessons:

- What is Christmas?
- 2. The importance of Mary and Joseph
- 3. The journey to Nazareth
- 4. The importance of the shepherds
- 5. The importance of the wise men
- 6. Why do Christians give gifts at Christmas?

Key Vocabulary: Christmas, Christianity, belief, understanding, importance, worship, celebration

## PSHE: Celebrating Difference

Intent: To understand and celebrate similarities and differences in people.

#### Sequence of lessons:

- 1. Identify similarities with members of my class
- 2. Identify differences with members of my class
- 3. I know what bullying is
- I know who I could talk to if I
  was feeling unhappy or being
  bullied
- 5. I know how to make new friends
- 6. I can tell you some ways I am different to my friends.

Key Vocabulary: similarity, difference, bully, bullied, kindness, talk, celebrate, share, special, unique, included, courage, diverse, deliberate, unfair, on purpose.

Impact: To work scientifically testing materials and their uses and orally explain what they have learnt.

Impact: Draw a design of a new playground using results from a survey.

Impact: To understand the Christmas story and why is matters to Christians.

Impact: To understand that nobody should be bullied because of differences and for children to know who they can talk to if they are worried.

## Art: Painting

Intent: To understand colour, texture and collage.

#### Sequence of lessons:

- To develop knowledge of colour mixing
- 2. To know how texture can be created with paint.
- 3. To use paint to explore texture and pattern.
- 4. To compose a collage choosing materials for effects.
- 5. To evaluate and improve artwork.

Key Vocabulary: colour, mix, texture, improve, evaluate, collage, detail, overlap, primary colour, secondary colour, surface

# Computing: Pictograms and Online Safety

Intent: To know how to be safe online

#### Sequence of lessons:

- 1. To understand that data can be represented in picture format
- 2. To contribute to a class pictogram
- 3. To use a pictogram to record results of an experiment.
- 4. To know how to search for information safely.
- 5. To share information safely
- 6. To learn about our digital footprint

Key Vocabulary: Digital, footprint, online safety, search, internet, share, pictogram, picture, data, represent

## PE: Gymnastics

Intent: To develop stability and control when performing travelling, balances and jumps

#### Sequence of lessons:

- 1. To explore travelling movements
- 2. To develop and combine travelling movements
- To develop quality when performing and linking shapes
- 4. To develop stability and control when performing balances
- 5. To continue to work on balances
- 6. To develop stability and control when performing jumps

Key Vocabulary: balance, jumps, travel, shape, link, performance, stability, combine, routine

### Music: Tempo

Intent: To create fast and slow sounds with their voices, bodies and instruments.

#### Sequence of lessons:

- To use voices and bodies expressively whilst exploring tempo
- 2. To practice a rhyme using fast and slow beats
- 3. To use voices to perform a song with fast and slow beats.
- To use singing voices and instruments to investigate fast and slow beats.
- 5. To demonstrate fast and slow beats within the context of a story.

Key Vocabulary: beat, fast, slow, singing voice, instrument

Impact: To create a collage

Impact: Children have an awareness of their use of devices and what a digital footprint is.

Impact: To link travelling, balancing and jumping into routines with control and quality.

Intent: To listen and respond to alternative fairytales including "The three little wolves and the big bad pig" and "Little Red"






Impact: Children to write their own alternative fairytale ensuring correct use of full stops and capital letters.
