



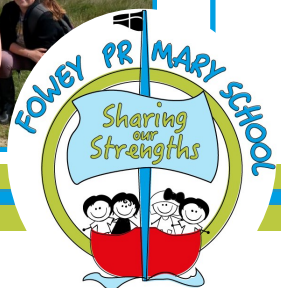

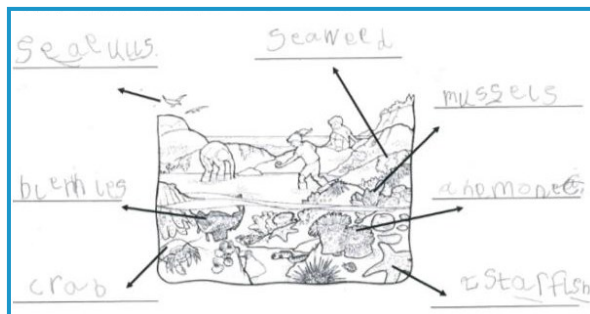
PARKING

EYFS

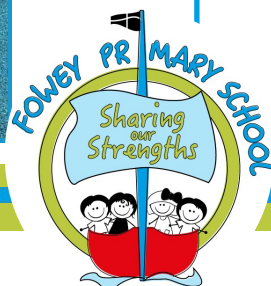
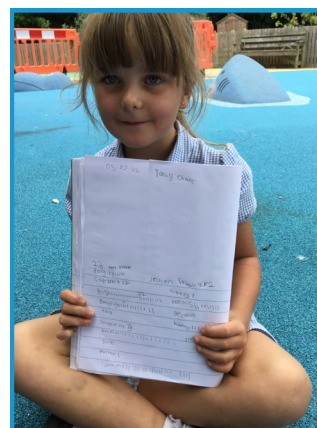

YEAR 1

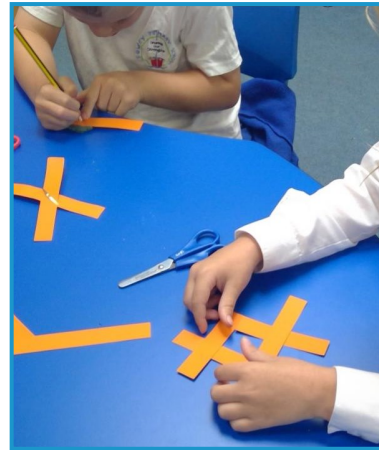

YEAR 2

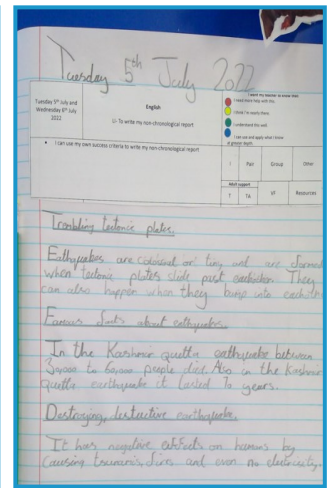
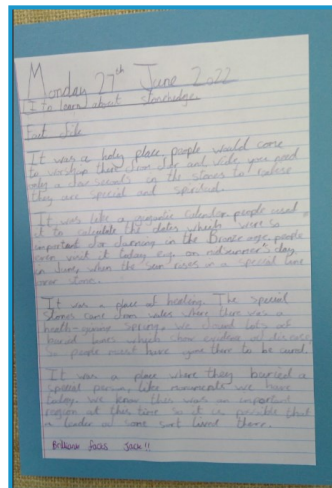

YEAR 3

In history, Polridmouth class have been learning about the Stone Age and the Bronze Age! They have engaged in lots of informative activities to help inform our understanding of the topic and have learnt some great facts.

YEAR 4



In Gribben, the children have been exploring their sentence construction by considering how a key character will feel at key parts of a story. They used conscience alley as a drama activity to help them develop their ideas and thoughts.

In maths, they have been exploring symmetry in shapes and completing lines of symmetry- lots of reflection took place.

They have also thought about musical composition using our Purple Mash computer programme, giving a review of different musical pieces.

Readymoney class enjoyed a visit from the Stay Safe Initiative. The children enjoyed workshops where they learnt how to stay safe online and manage with friendship issues.

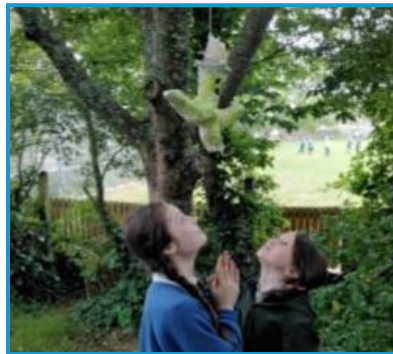
